



PROMOTING THE BAY OF FUNDY NEW7WONDERS OF NATURE CAMPAIGN -- IN SCHOOLS

The Bay of Fundy is a 270 km long ocean bay that stretches between the provinces of **New Brunswick** and Nova Scotia on Canada's east coast. The Bay of Fundy is a globally significant natural wonder for its Highest Tides in the World, dinosaurs and fossils, green tidal energy, ecology, whales, culture and UNESCO designations. The website also features the work of students from around the globe inspired by the New7Wonders campaign. Teachers can hit on every aspect of the curriculum: history (read about the original 7 Wonders), current events, math, writing, computer skills, public speaking/ fluency, reading for information, art, geography, cultures of the world and more. Curriculum suggestions include:

- Create a theme day at school; create School Champions.
- Create a video to educate students, teachers and parents on the New7Wonders project and the Bay of Fundy.
- Chose 10 candidates; let them investigate and research one of the finalist sites and present the project to other students and parents.
- Create posters and scale models of one or more sites.
- Create a PowerPoint presentation.
- Host a Wonder-ful World Expo for parents and children, featuring craft stations and story-telling. Encourage school voting at the expo.
- Have the students write advertising campaigns to promote the candidates; create podcasts.
- Research and create commercials; Produce panel presentations and articles for the school newspaper.
- Launch a project to have students campaign for their favourite wonders. Have a school wide vote. Their persuasive writing would be posted on the school's web page.
- Create websites highlighting students' choices.
- Create a quilt of the New7Wonders.
- Have a "Wonders Team" create websites with quizzes, games, etc.

Students will have the opportunity to intensify their study of world history by participating.
